



The summer is always full of construction & maintenance projects and this year is no different. The following are just a few of the projects planned.

SRP will soon be done with their design work and be in to replace the secondarys as planned.

The street work will start in the next week with the valley gutter replaced along Helio and the seal coat work, following the week after. Please refer to the map in the Outlines that shows when your street, (weather permitting) is scheduled. Not all streets are scheduled for seal coat this year. This product requires a 24-hour cure period so please, DO NOT drive on it!

Palm tree trimming is scheduled for the third week of June and is expected to take five to six weeks. Always a good time to go on vacation!

As most everyone knows the work has started on the Sports Plex project. There is a live camera feed link on the web page, so you can watch from your sofa. This area is strictly off limits, because it will soon be full of trenches and many other hazards.

We have been notified by South West Gas that they are planning to come into the park and also do some improvements to their system, linking up two sections of service. At this time, we do not have any estimate when this work might commence, but we have told them that we prefer to have the work done prior to the start of season. SRP just finished their upgrade on Broadway, bringing in a second source for the primary feed, this will supposedly help us in the event of a power failure.

The West Pool deck will be ground down in a small section and new Kool deck applied.

LED lamps will be installed park wide in all the common elements/buildings. This will greatly save in electrical costs. The replacement lamps/bulbs are being paid for by the Social Board out of the Bingo Funds.

The design work for a small addition on the back of the ceramics for the kilns has been completed. We now take this design through the city for approval, and assuming they don't have any issues, we will get this project also completed before the end of the summer. This will move the kilns out of the Ceramics room and into an outside area that is naturally ventilated.

The railing has already been replaced at the Lawn Bowling green. We will also be moving the large bleachers from Shuffleboard over to the tennis complex, and putting in smaller bleachers under the existing shade structure. This is part of the Shuffleboard club's plan submitted to Planning and the Condo Board

We have numerous paint projects for the summer, including the flag pole. The key card readers will be installed on all three pedestrian gates at the front, which will require that a key card be used to both enter AND exit the gate. This will force any pedestrian entering or leaving the park, who is not a resident to pass by the guard house. This item had a 75% approval on the recently completed Long Range Plan.

The wi-fi project is to start shortly after July 1 and be up and running by October 1. DISH TV, will be upgrading their service as well and by the fall, you will have HD TV and 12 additional channels.

As normal, we will go through every single building and facility and look for items that might need repair or paint.
