



Please Note: Shriners are NO longer accepting scrap metal. They are still recycling cans but NO scrap Metal.





Next Monday is Memorial Day and as normal we will be closed for that Holiday. Starting approximately the week of June 3rd, major street work will begin along Bonanza, the 900 block of Navajo and Aero and the 800 and 900 blocks of Merlin.

The asphalt will be removed totally, regraded, an island is to be installed in the 900 block of Aero, similar to the zero block of Aero, and new street lights will be installed all along these new roads. Street lights will be the new commercial LED that was installed on the 800 block of Merlin last year.

This is the beginning of a many years long project where all streets and lights will be replaced in Venture Out. We will follow our street consultants plan, which is first targeting the streets that are in the worst condition, based on his assessment. That means that streets such as Helio and Fairchild which are brand new will not be slated for any kind of replacement for probably 20 years from now. If you are curious how your street falls into the masterplan, you can find his report on the web site under the Condo Board Reports. "Venture out PMA Report Revised 2016 (streets)" Seal coating will take place late in the summer.

The construction schedule is published in this month's outlines and it will take thirty days, start to finish to get this project done. All homeowners in these blocks have been contacted and we are giving them options for parking. These areas are not to be driven on when they start construction. There will be open trenches for lights and grading stakes placed throughout the site. Yes, it will be a hassle, but the result should be worth it. I always recommend that when we have major projects such as these happening, if you can do it, its an excellent time to take a vacation and get away from the noise and disruption because there is no way around it, it will be very inconvenient.

The construction schedule published is also the ANTICIPATED schedule. Any delay in City permits on the lights or bad weather can push that back. For instance, if it rains, the site must dry out, before they can commence working. You cannot pave over a wet subgrade. We thank everyone in advance for your co-operation on this major project.

There have been some break in's in the RV's and the Security have caught several individuals around the park and other's jumping over the wall as they approach. Most all of these are night time events. We are getting a bid on a perimeter laser alarm but that will simply tell us if someone scaled a particular section of the wall. We still have to find them and with one rover at night, covering 160 acres, with many places to hide, it is not easy. At my request last year, the Board and Infrastructure Committee are looking at potentially raising some of our walls in the park that are easily breached. There are many options out there, a taller wall such as you see along Leisure World, is an engineered wall (anything taller than six feet) and requires permits from the City to install. I did get bids on that exact wall about three summers ago and at the time it was \$110/a linear foot. We have a mile of wall around the community, so you can do the math and understand why the Board is taking a hard look at this. In the meantime, we appreciate everyone keeping their eyes open, and if you see someone suspicious, contact Security immediately, don't intervene yourself.

The annual Palm tree trimming is scheduled to start June 18th. Everyone that has lived in the park for years, knows this drill. It will be the same crew as the last two years, so welcome them back, they do a pretty good job. This project takes five weeks.

If you noticed a drone flying overhead the first part of May, that was a thermal imaging drone, that produced some very interesting images of VO. Specifically it was to look for any major water leaks, and we are happy to report there are none. Just the normal leaking standpipes and irrigation issues. Staff is working on a list of leaking standpipes through the summer and irrigation repair is just a constant job.

The annual statement and coupons will be mailed out shortly. The summer newsletter comes separately now and is e-mailed to 1500 home owners (that saves a LOT of money). If you have an e-mail, but have never received your summer newsletter electronically, please contact Deanna in our office so we can get you set up. For those of you who are haunting your mailbox looking for that concert series form, getting your summer newsletter by e-mail OR going on line and printing it, is the fastest way you will get it.

The Board will hold a teleconference meeting on June 14th at 9:00 a.m. in the Oasis, as a mid-summer check in. A tentative agenda is posted in this month's outlines.
