The Security Staff logged in 2,468 vehicles at the front gate for the month. The total amount of gate access by residents, contractors and visitors totaled 18,384. The original 18,384cars should be multiplied by an average of 2 persons equaling a total of 36,768 people the staff assisted during the month of June.



## Manager's Corner



#### August, 2019

This month's occupancy is 300 or 16.9% vs. 305 last time reported, vs 202 the year prior. There are currently 45 renters in the park. We normally rely on the Post Office to help us sort out who has moved out and not checked out with us, however they have new staff in there and so we are not quite certain that these numbers are correct. Therefore, checking out at ADMIN is important.

We continue to enjoy unseasonably cooler temperatures in Arizona, while the rest of the county is in the middle of the heat wave. The pool's have not quite warmed up to 'bathwater' temps this season; and when you get out of the pool, (morning or evening, its chilly?!) No heavy monsoon storms have hit yet, but we could desperately use the rain.

We have been informed by the drainage contractor that they are behind schedule with our drainpipe in the southwest retention basin (pet walk area), as they are waiting for all the utilities to move their services first. I'm not very optimistic that this drain line will be in before we have our first major storm, but we contact them every week to make sure they don't put us on the back burner.

Tree trimming is nearing completion and the park blow down follows behind that. n discussion with our contractor, he is telling us that some of our trees are getting too tall for the lifts. The lifts are 85 feet and while they can have 100' lifts they don't like using those. Having been up there myself at that height, I don't blame them for not wanting to go much higher. That will be another project for the Board when they return this fall, Long Range Planning for trees.

The Condo Board approved the West Pool design contract. The engineers have already been in the park starting to survey the pool. The timing for this is tight. For the Board to decide in the fall most of the design work will have to be done prior to their return. The design chosen was the one recommended by the West Pool Ad Hoc committee and published in the Summer Newsletter. This committee met many times with lot owners, to get input on what that new pool should contain. The end design is unique. It will allow multiple uses in the pool simultaneously; doubling the programming opportunities for the pool. We will be anxious to see more fleshed out designs in the weeks ahead.

Dish has told me that they are ready to bring in their new 1 Gig line and greatly improve their internet service. While they do not yet have the pricing figured out, they said they SHOULD, be able to offer up to 50 Mbps. Century Link's rep has told me that they now offer up to 100 mbps in the park. We have been testing the Verizon equipment also. It appears that it might be a viable alternative for homeowners. Again, when we have more information on that we will let you know but it appears that multiple internet options will be there for the owners this fall.

The Shuffleboard snack bar is rising up. Keith has that built so well, that I think we can use it as a storm shelter. At the same time, the Activity Office is getting permanent walls. They have been in 'temporary' quarter since 2004. Teresa has moved back over to the west side, leaving the Out-Lines and the conference room in the east building.

The new air conditioning units were installed. We are still waiting on one piece that is not yet here, and they are working to shake out the bugs in the system. I will be interested to see if have a reduction in our bills considering the ability to control the system using a computer.

Seal coating for the east side is scheduled late in the summer season towards the fall, we wait for cooler temperatures to apply that coating. As normal we have a long long list of summer projects we are working on and it is always a race to the finish.

In closing, I want to warn people about how sophisticated cyber criminals are getting these days. I would caution you against opening any attachment, UNLESS, you have a long message from the person sending it, and or you call them to make sure it is real. We have received very sophisticated attempts in our office, disquised as vendors we have worked with, to try to get us to open an invoice for example. Nowadays, they can co-opt just about anyone's e-mail address and make it appear as if it is coming from that person, causing all kinds of grief. Nothing is safe out there from internet thieves so use

extreme caution when using your computers. It might be time to go back to cuneiform and clav tablets.
