VENTURE OUT AT MESA COVID-19 ADVISORY

Requirements for Common Elements

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving and the exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, but there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccine for COVID-19. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness and even death.

PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

Venture Out At Mesa, Inc. (“Venture Out”) has put in place preventative measures for the community to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

However, Venture Out cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19 while in the Venture Out community. Venture Out cannot prevent you from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while in our community and while using Venture Out’s amenities. Therefore, if you choose to enter into the Venture Out community and participate in Venture Out’s amenities you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

RESTRICTIONS AND GUIDELINES

Venture Out has established restrictions and guidelines regarding all common elements. The restrictions and guidelines are posted at all common elements within the park, have been sent via FAST Mail, the Venture Out-lines and made available in printed form.

Residents, renters, guests, and contractors are expected to:

- 1) Be fully aware of the posted restrictions and guidelines.
- 2) At all times, while within the park, comply with the posted restrictions and guidelines.
- 3) Ensure that safe personal procedures are being followed, including, wearing masks, social distancing (6’), and proper sanitation.
- 4) **GUESTS:** *At the present time, guests are not permitted to use common elements within the park*

CONDO BOARD PRIORITIES

The VO Condo Board recognizes that this is a difficult time for everyone. We all come to Venture Out to enjoy the multitude of activities and to socialize with friends. Yet, this year is different. Therefore, ***the Boards priorities are focused on:***

- 1) The health and safety of all our residents and staff
- 2) Compliance with Federal, State and County guidelines and restrictions, regarding the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3) Compliance with guidelines from the Center for Disease Control, state and county health services.

The Condo Board has incorporated the above advisories, restrictions, and recommendations into the Guidelines posted within the park. The intent is to maintain a safe and sanitary environment while supporting the recreational and social activities that can be conducted safely.

We have been advised by our lawyers and insurance provider that ***we (VO) must do the following:***

- 1) Establish safe procedures, restrictions and guidelines.
- 2) Communicate the established safe procedures, restrictions and guidelines to all residents, renters, guests and contractors, by postings, FAST Mails, and dissemination of printed copies.
- 3) Monitor for compliance.

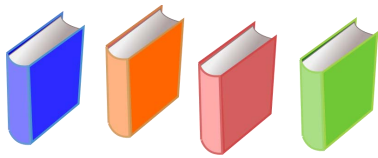

Manager's Corner

November 20, 2020

This week's occupancy is 676 or 39% vs 535 at last report and 1137 for the year prior. There are currently 76 renters in the park.

We had two more COVID-19 cases reported to our office on Wednesday. This time however they did not identify themselves, but called to let us know they were sick, and they felt they got sick on the way down to the park. This underlines the need for the FASTMAIL which was sent out last Friday asking people to voluntarily self-quarantine when they first arrive. 75% of those that reported to our office, had recently arrived, and felt they contracted the disease in the process of traveling. Meanwhile in AZ we are seeing a very sharp rise in cases reaching 4123 new cases on Thursday, getting much too close to summer levels. Experts believe that at least 11% of all Arizonans have had cases of Covid, or for every ten people you meet, one might have it currently or had been infected. This next week is Thanksgiving and we all must be very careful how we celebrate with our family and friends and keep that number from rising even more.

The CDC also issued a warning on Thursday 11/19, advising against all travel over the Thanksgiving Holiday, which is how serious they feel the situation has become, nationwide.

Governor Ducey held a news conference on 11/18 and advised that all Arizonans wear masks when around others that do not live in your household. He did not issue a statewide mask ordinance, but as they are required in Maricopa county and Mesa, it is a moot point for us. He did cite a new study from the CDC which was released last week that now states, that masks also protect the wearer. He said the state will release 'official guidance for celebrating Thanksgiving' and asking everyone to limit gatherings that are INSIDE your home. (those guidelines were not published at the time of the news conference) He also mentioned the thousands of snowbirds arriving daily from outside the state. Because of the returning snowbirds, the government will be instituting testing sites in all the airports so that new arrivals can get tested upon entering the state if they choose. It is strictly voluntary.

When they finally publish their guidelines for a 'safe Thanksgiving' we will send that out via a FASTMAIL so that everyone receives it prior to that event.

Occupancy in the park is currently 39% and we are running about 26% behind where we were this time, last year. I feel that with the recent rise in COVID-19 cases across the nation, people are hesitating on coming back, and waiting to see what happens. Just this week, the Cal Am properties announced they have canceled their concert series this season, so now it appears that the majority of the parks up and down the street are planning only the basics for the season. Fortunately, with a vaccine on the near horizon, we hopefully should all be able to see Covid 19 in the rear-view mirror by this summer.

Because our Administration Office is seeing everyone as they check in and some of those parties probably had Covid when they checked in, we are using the Clorox electrostatic machine at least three times daily to disinfect our lobby and the conference room where all the residents are getting their badges this year. I can tell you the staff greatly appreciates the installation of the glass windows this summer as well as the extra expenditures on the sanitation machines. I know Teresa and her staff feel the same at the Activity Office.

As next week is Thanksgiving, we will have our staff in sanitizing as they normally do now, but there will be no trash pick-up. If you could, hold on to that trash until Monday, or if necessary, take it over to the garbage containers. A lot of food dumped into the garbage containers can attract a variety of wildlife.















Please be courteous to your fellow residents and do not bring any guests to the common elements. As it stands now, guests may go directly to your home and only your home. If you wish to get out of your house, there are several nearby parks for walks. Carol Perkinson very helpfully posted these on the bulletin board at the Post Office.

Finally, this morning I received an e-mail from a resident about the large number of people entering the Post Office without wearing their masks. Masks are required in all the common elements and in particular the Post Office, that can be so congested and has such low ceilings. Please protect each other and always wear your masks when inside ANY common element or facility. Please follow the posted guidelines at each club. Help us stop this dreadful disease, please.

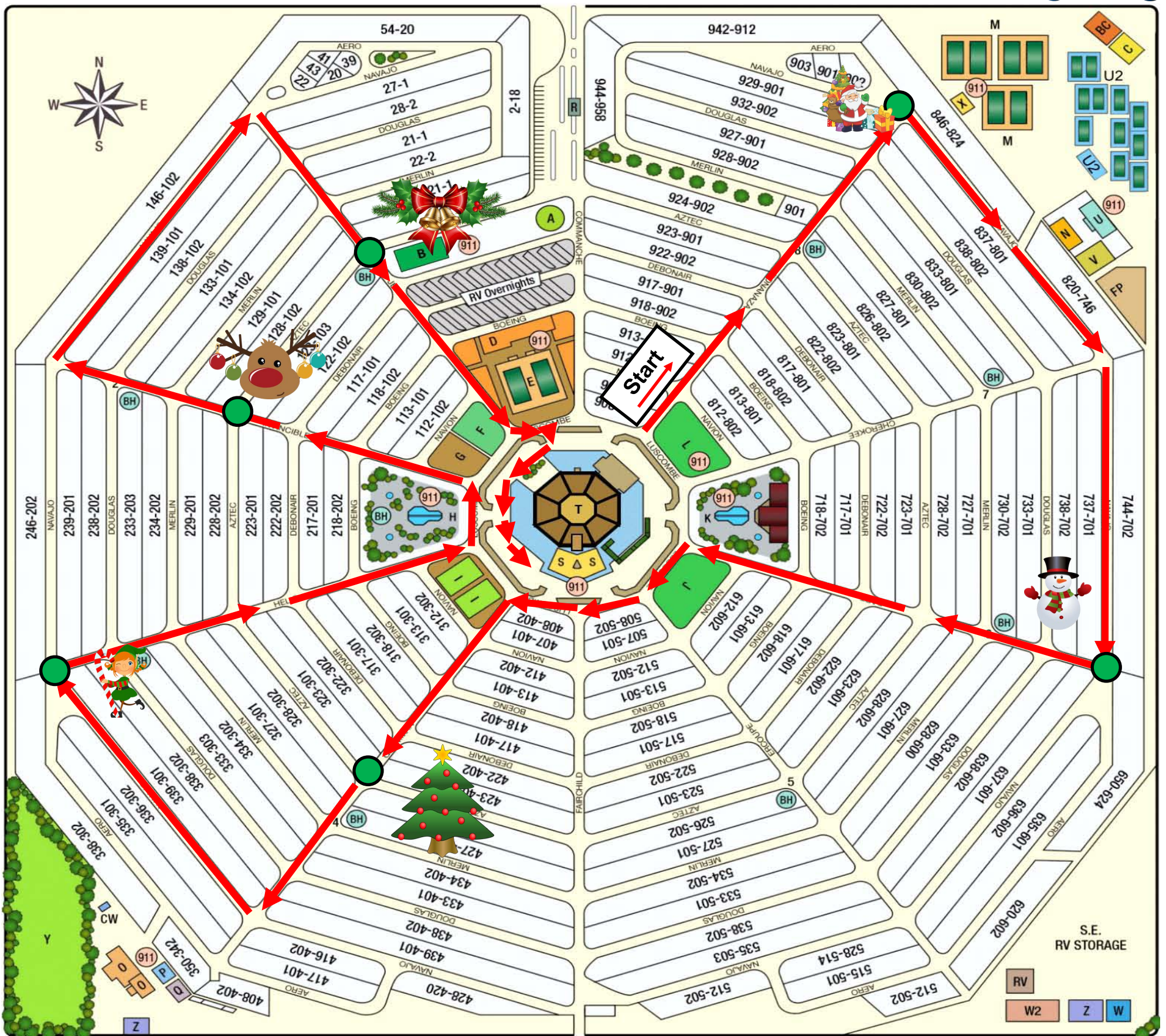

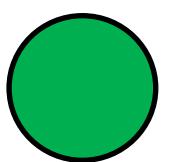

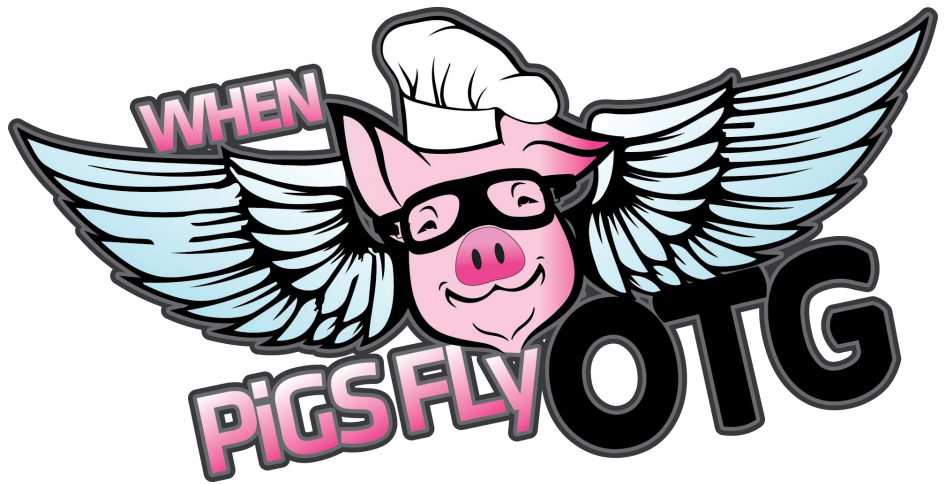
