It's Time To Register YOUR PET

A Few Things to Know About Pets in Venture Out

1. Pets are required to be registered at the Activity Office. Proof of current rabies vaccination is needed for dogs. Upon registration a tag will be issued which must be attached to the collar or harness of the pet. You will also receive stickers for your badge, and a "Rules & Guidelines for Pets at Venture Out".
2. Pets are to be on a leash unless in the gated Pet Walk area or in your private yard.
3. Pets may be walked on the streets and sidewalks of VO. They may not be taken to "do their business" in yards other than your own, or any common areas other than the Pet Walk. Be prepared to clean up any accidents that may occur when walking your dog (carry bags and water).
4. Pets are not allowed on any common areas other than the Pet Walk, streets, and sidewalks.
5. When using the Pet Walk, use the Entrance and Exits as marked.
6. A Pet Wash is available for your use. Please bring and take your own supplies.
7. For more information, please read Section 2, Article 8 in our Condominium Rule & Regulations.




Manager's Corner

August, 2022

This month's occupancy is 510 or 29% occupied vs. 522 the month prior and vs. 389 the year prior. There are currently 35 renters in the park.

Everyone should be well aware by now that we had a major monsoon storm the night of 7/17 and many units suffered extensive damage. We have contacted the owners with clearly visible damages however we are stressing to all owners, to please have someone thoroughly inspect your unit. While we posted a list of damaged units, do not assume that the list is complete. We cannot see if you have had any kind of roof damage for example, and there was a great deal of flying debris around the park. They are projecting a very active summer monsoon season, so please do not hesitate to inspect your unit before rain can add to the wind damage.

A drone picture of the park is posted on the web site which will allow you to zoom on to your lot and at least make a cursory inspection of your property. A list of KNOWN damaged units is also on the web site.

Three roll offs have been placed in the 600, 700 and 100 blocks for the next two weeks so that owners can clean up around their units. These were the blocks that were damaged most heavily. The maintenance trailer is parked in the SE corner and if you have salvageable aluminum, please place it carefully on this trailer so that maintenance can secure the load at night. If another storm comes in, we don't want a repeat of pieces of metal flying around in the SE corner causing more damage.

If you have skirting damage, we really need you to find someone to replace that skirting in the next two weeks. A pack of Coyotes have been seen in VO and nothing suits them more than making a den under a unit, which of course could also cause damage to your home. If you have not repaired the skirting by the 5th, notices will be coming out. We attached a list of willing caretakers to the website if you need assistance. More on the coyotes below.

Thanks again to all the volunteers who helped inspect, secure units and clean up after the storm. Maintenance worked one solid week, cutting down trees and cleaning up the common elements and needless to say, they were very tired by the end of the week. They are still cleaning up this week.

West Pool construction has been moving along since we have been fortunate not to receive extreme amounts of rain that could delay the project. The street light heads are in and will start to be installed on 8/2. Supply issues have been a concern all year long, so we purchased all the pavers for the pool, well ahead of the need for them and they are secured on site. Masonry block, something that used to be stockpiled around the valley is now a 4 to 6 week order and that is a short time frame. We have had some vendors say up to 14 weeks. So we keep working through these supply issues to stay ahead of the curve, hopefully. This week, if you are watching, they have installed almost all the plumbing around and inside the pool. Foundations are poured for the pump house. Soon you will see the pool formed if you are watching the web camera.

Palm tree trimming has also been steady, and they continue to do a good job. The blow down of the park will start in approximately two weeks. We are asking that all the storm debris has been cleared by then or we will not be able to get behind many of the units.

In closing we have had a pack of coyotes spotted in the park. Sadly, they attacked one small dog. We have contacted all authorities on this pack and how to remove them. They were of little help and said they will only come in, if they present a danger to people. They say this is the time that they are raising their pups so looking for shelter is natural for them, ie under units. These animals move along the canal that borders the park and easily scale the walls. Security is watching for them at night but can only scare them off. Please do not leave pets unattended for even a short period of time and secure all trash so that it does not present an easy meal for them.

We hope that where ever you are you are enjoying a great summer.
