# It's Time To Register YOUR PET

A Few Things to Know About Pets in Venture Out

1. Pets are required to be registered at the Activity Office. Proof of current rabies vaccination is needed for dogs. Upon registration a tag will be issued which must be attached to the collar or harness of the pet. You will also receive stickers for your badge, and a "Rules & Guidelines for Pets at Venture Out".
2. Pets are to be on a leash unless in the gated Pet Walk area or in your private yard.
3. Pets may be walked on the streets and sidewalks of VO. They may not be taken to "do their business" in yards other than your own, or any common areas other than the Pet Walk. Be prepared to clean up any accidents that may occur when walking your dog (carry bags and water).
4. Pets are not allowed on any common areas other than the Pet Walk, streets, and sidewalks.
5. When using the Pet Walk, use the Entrance and Exits as marked.
6. A Pet Wash is available for your use. Please bring and take your own supplies.
7. For more information, please read Section 2, Article 8 in our Condominium Rule & Regulations.

# Manager's Corner

September, 2022

This month's occupancy is 503 or 29% occupied, vs. 510 the month prior and 388 the year prior. There are currently 37 renters in the park.

Summer is rushing by and for staff even more so. We continue to work though a project list that tops over 200 items, in addition to the ongoing construction at the West Pool. The 48 " storm drain project will start in October, with the receipt of the third installment of the assessments. The west pool crews start sometimes as early as 3:00 a.m. and generally will stop around 1:00 p.m. when it gets extremely hot. We have posted some photos of the pool on the Facebook page and also on the web site so you can see the progress

Maricopa County Health Department, which is also involved in approving the pool permits, issued our permit, then looked at it again and wanted us to change the elevations and have a gentler slope on both ends of the large pool down to the deep ends. This would mean that those users near the ends might be standing in about six inches more water than those towards the center. We have applied for a variance to keep the profile that was originally designed and requested by West Pool Committee. One of the wrinkles with both County and City during the permitting process, is that both have the caveat, that if they miss anything during the initial approval they can always come back, and request changes be made. This is frustrating for the owners of that project and can create some delays. While we await the approval of that variance, we continue on with the rest of the project, laying the storm drains, plumbing, electrical conduit, retaining walls, and are now in the process of building the pump house.

The west pool will have more landscaping than the east pool, and lower level, amber lighting to create a more 'resort' feel to the pool, so we are excited to see the final product. Carrie is working on the programing for the pool, keeping in mind that it can serve double duty with two sides that can have different activities simultaneously.

The 'Crack-seal' project for all the streets in the park will start on Monday September 12th. See the map that is in this month's Out-Lines so that you can plan accordingly. Crack seal means that they use a liquid tar to come through and seal any cracks. During the period that they are doing this on your street, you need to stay off the street for at least 30 minutes letting the tar dry, or you will track it on to your driveway and lift the tar out of the cracks. Immediately following this work, we will start the park wide blow down. All debris from the 7/17 storm needs to be disposed of, so it does not collect this trash as we move through the easements.

During the process of summer projects, we found that the Clay Arts 'Popcorn' ceiling was peeling. Anytime you have a popcorn ceiling you want to test it for asbestos before removing it, and sure enough it came back 95% 'hot'. Asbestos is only a concern when it becomes airborne or friable. Removal has to be done by a licensed contractor and because the cost is over \$10,000 we have to get three bids. Our contractor we successfully used for the west pool has told me that he is three weeks out on scheduling. At this time we are still trying to get more bids. Everything has to be removed from the Clay Art's building, we will then have to go back in and re-assemble everything and do any repairs necessary. Because of this work Clay Arts is not likely to re-open on time in September, but when it is re-opened it will be almost a new facility.

We are also still waiting on the fencing contractor to repair the Pickle Ball fences damaged in the storm. All contractors are very busy, so you wait your turn until they can get to you. They are aware that season starts soon.

While some areas in AZ have received an above average rainfall, Lake Mead unfortunately sits at the lowest levels in its history. In January, Arizona will suffer a 21% cut in our allocation to Colorado River water, which will at first largely affect the farmers. When owners return this fall, you will start to hear a lot of discussion about water conservation and what we can do to help and reduce our usage. In the meantime we welcome any and all precipitation.

We hope you are enjoying your summer.
