Green Committee Tips

Conserving water enables the City of Mesa to maximize and stretch all of its water supplies. Here's the best ways to save water here.

Sweep and collect dust on your porches and driveways. Washing and blowing does not eliminate the dust. Reconsider power washing your park model as leakage around windows, doors, and siding could occur.

Take a 5 minute shower, or reduce your shower time by a minute.

If it's pee, let it be. If it's brown, flush it down. It's your house, so you know when to do it.

Use the \$6 car wash across the street that recycles water, not the wash stations in our park.

Find and fix leaks. A leaky toilet flapper or signs of moisture around your house are water wasted.

Choose only drought resistant plants. These plants require little water once established. Collect water from your sinks and showers to water your plants.

Exercise your choice in purchasing low flow toilets, showerheads, and faucets in your park model.

Turn off the water when brushing your teeth, shaving, and washing your hands for 20 seconds.

Go meatless one night or more each week.

Be the change that makes the difference!

JK Dan Baldwin has studied the assassination since the mid-seventies and has spoken to thousands of people on what the government/media say vs. what the actual records and documentation say. His presentation includes how the assassination occurred and key elements of the cover-up that followed including: documentation that the accused assassin was not in the "sniper's nest," that there were two Lee Harvey Oswalds, the JFK autopsy cover up, government destruction of primary evidence, and why it all matters today.

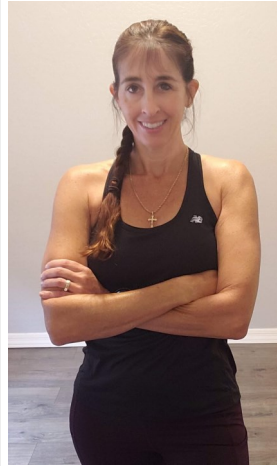

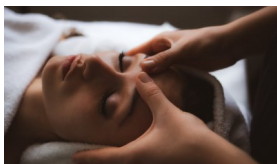

Manager's Corner

December, 2022

This month's occupancy is 1193 or 66% compared to 832 in November and 1040 for the same period last year. There are currently 187 renters in the park. So 150 more arrivals than last year, it looks like a very full and very busy season ahead!

The storm drain work has been pushed back a week as we await the arrival of the liner from the East coast. They now anticipate to start their work on December 5th, with the arrival of the liner on the 12th. Because they would like to finish this job prior to the Holidays they will be working long hours to complete it. The areas that will be blocked off will be small and should not inconvenience most people. When the manhole at the Broadway gate is open, they will have the exit blocked but not the entry. A section in the line will be opened in the 400 block of Navajo behind some homes. This will facilitate pulling the liner through as it is so heavy it cannot be pulled the entire length, without the additional opening.

We will be putting out a schedule on FASTMAIL with areas to be shut down, but we expect to update that daily depending on how the work progresses and if they have to slow down OR can speed the project up. It all depends on how easy it is to pull the liner through the existing pipe. Once the project is complete they will run a camera down the entire length of the line to inspect it. They will be using heavy equipment ; all construction zones will be strictly off limits to only authorized personnel.

Which brings us back to the West Pool, we still have people walking or biking through this zone, when the contractors have to open both gates. No one other than authorized personnel are to be in the West Pool Construction site. Especially Invincible (North side of the pool) from Luscombe to Boeing is strictly off limits, no matter if the gates are open. It puts everyone in danger if someone whizzes through on a bike when pickups and backhoes are moving in and out of there.

The Pool is moving along quickly now, we have underground work still going in for drainage before we start to lay pavers. Pool equipment should be arriving shortly for installation, big heavy equipment that we need to safely offload into the new pump house, so please stay clear.

The pebble tec surface will be the very last item to be completed on the pool, just prior to filling it. Prior to the pebble tec surfacing, the City and County come out and do a complete inspection of the pool and then authorize that final process. We had to take down the live West Pool Camera since it was up in the ballroom and with season on, it was a trip and fall hazard for those using the facility. We will continue to post photos on Facebook and the Website for everyone that is off site.

We are asking everyone once again, that you get your third party rental forms into the Admin office at least one week in advance. On November 1st we had lines going out the door with all kinds of people coming in to rent a unit with absolutely no advance paperwork filled out. When that happens, those renters or owners have to go back to the end of the line and sit in the lobby until the front desk slows down enough that the ladies can take the time to process them. This results in unhappy new renters and owners. The forms are at the Admin office and also on line. Please take the few minutes it takes to fill them out and then drop off to Admin or e-mail them. The front desk processes around 600 of these each season, which puts them into our Administrative software, but also they are input into the gatehouse software. If this is done properly in advance, check in is smooth, and your guests only need to wait for badges if they are first time renters.

This year the Holidays both fall on Sunday, with the official observed Holiday both Mondays, December 26th and January 2nd. There will be no trash pick-up on those days, and if possible please hold excess trash until they start to pick up again on Tuesdays. Piling stacks of trash around the dumpsters may prevent the City from picking up, causing staff to have to clear everything, before we can get them in. We do not want the City to skip us after those two major Holidays.

If you are traveling for the Holidays in the next few weeks, travel safely and we will see you in 2023!

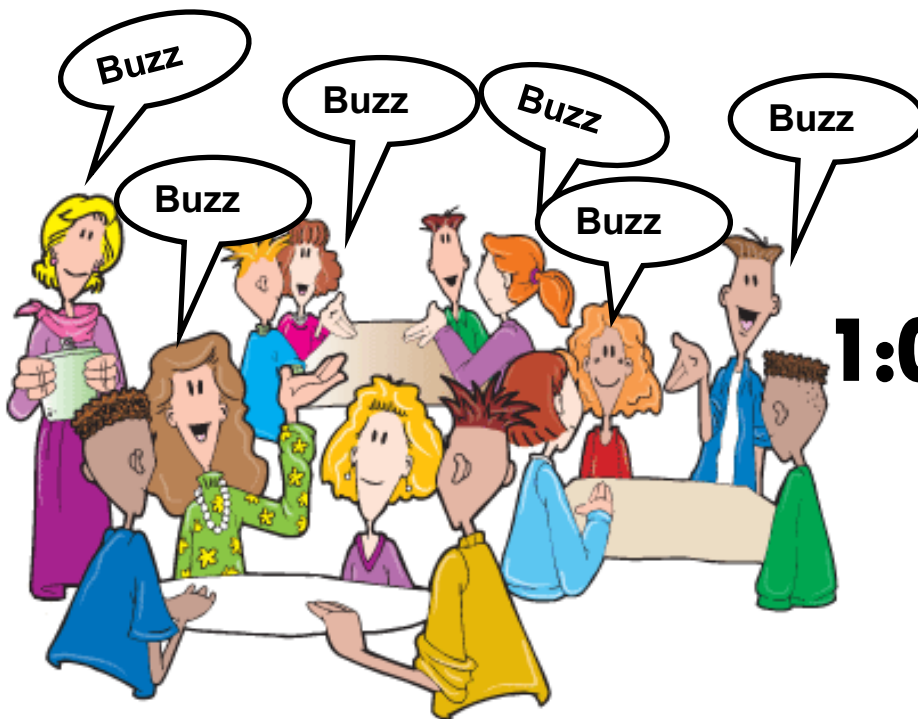
