The City of Mesa has enacted Ordinance 5734 providing guidance for Short Term Rent-als (29 days or less). This is not a Venture Out regulation but affects owners that provide short term rentals. Regulation would not apply to the normal monthly rentals that occur at VO.

New Mesa Law Regulating Short-term Rent-als effective February 2023

Short-term rental (29 days or less) property owners must acquire a special City of Mesa license.
Requires emergency contact informa-tion for emergencies and complaints.
Requires notifying neighboring prop-erties that a property will be used as a short-term rental.

Establishes civil penalties against owners and others.

Requires liability insurance.






