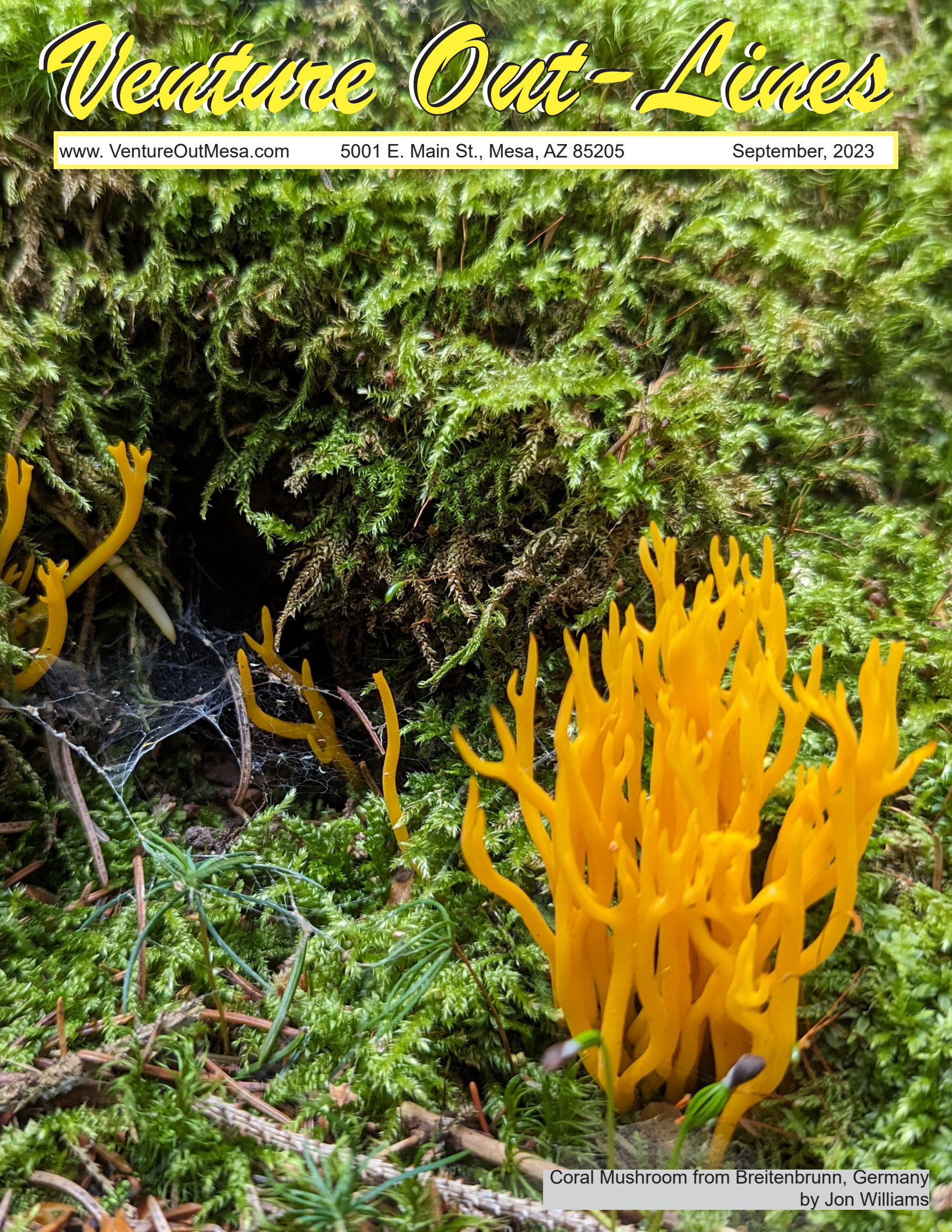

Note:

The City of Mesa has enacted Ordinance 5734 providing guidance for Short Term Rentals (29 days or less). This is not a Venture Out regulation but affects owners that provide short term rentals. Regulation would not apply to the normal monthly rentals that occur at VO.

New Mesa Law Regulating Short-term Rentals effective February 2023

- Short-term rental (29 days or less) property owners must acquire a special City of Mesa license.
- Requires emergency contact information for emergencies and complaints.
- Requires notifying neighboring properties that a property will be used as a short-term rental.
- Establishes civil penalties against owners and others.
- Requires liability insurance.
