Fall Classic Tournament — Our Signature Fundraiser !

The Fall Classic Tournament is our largest and most visible fundraising event and has long been recognized as one of the best-organized tournaments in the Valley. It attracts hundreds of players from across the region and takes a *village* of volunteers to make it run smoothly.

Taco Salad Luncheons — Tasty and Terrific

Held several times during the season at the Baja Bistro in the Activity Center, Taco Salad Luncheons are always a hit. Volunteers work alongside Bistro staff to prepare and serve delicious taco salads to Venture Out residents. (Volunteers must complete VO's *food handlers* training.) It's social, satisfying, and supports the Club in a big way!

Bake Sales — Sweet Support

Bake sales often accompany other VO events such as rummage sales or club fundraisers. Members donate baked goods (homemade treasures encouraged—but store-bought or a small donation works too!), and volunteers help price and sell items to residents. Simple, sweet, and surprisingly effective.

Rummage Sales — Undiscovered Treasures

Typically held twice per season at Courts 7 & 8 (behind the laundromat), rummage sales invite the entire VO community to donate gently used goods—from household items and tools to sports equipment and bikes. Volunteers help with collecting, sorting, pricing, selling, and donating leftovers to local charities.
